

Event Guidelines

1. Event will have a maximum of 16 performances.
2. Sequencing of the events will be done based on age group, from youngest to oldest.
3. No performance may be longer than **6 minutes** in duration.
4. Performances are **not** transferable from one choreographer to another by choreographers. As such, if a choreographer reserves a slot, but determines that he/she is not able to utilize it or unwilling to choreograph the performance, this slot will be returned to the board members for allocation to any other choreographer as per the board's discretion.
5. Each performance must include a minimum of **eight** participants.
6. For a successful execution of the event, we will allow only the choreographer(s) and 2 helpers for each performance in the backstage area.
7. To help us before, during and after the event, we will **require 1 parent** volunteers from each performance group. The activities will be coordinated by the event directors.
8. Entry Ticket is waived only for 1 choreographer and the Participants only in the group.
9. We encourage other community members to help us by volunteering at this and other IAAI events.
10. Students requiring Silver Cord hours can help out too.
11. IAAI Does not charge for any performance in any way. The participation is free for all the performances.

Choreographer Guidelines:

1. Minimum age for a Choreographer is **16** years.
2. Each Choreographer is allowed to choreograph only **one** performance.
3. No more than two choreographers can be named per performance.
4. Once approved, the choreographer name cannot be changed.
5. No additional names as choreographers will be added, printed or announced.
6. Choreographers & Parents are responsible for –
 - Finding a location for practice.
 - Determining practice schedules and frequency.
 - Determining and managing costs associated with performance.

Performer Guidelines:

1. Minimum age for a performer is **five** years.
2. No performer will be allowed to participate in more than one event.
